

ITINERARY

Day o North America

Depart this day from your North American departure point on your overnight flight to Europe.

Night in flight.

Day 1 Warsaw

Witamy w Polsce!—Welcome to Poland!

Today you will arrive into Warsaw's Frederic Chopin Airport. After retrieving your luggage and moving through customs, you will be met by your English-speaking Polish guide who will be with you throughout your time in Poland. Afternoon familiarization tour.

Night in Warsaw (1).

Day 2 Warsaw

After breakfast, visit Warsaw city center for a sight-seeing tour with a local guide. See Holy Cross Church, the Warsaw Stock Exchange, Warsaw University, Piłsudski Square (Tomb of the Unknown Soldier), and Potocki Palace. Visit the Royal Castle—former official residence of Polish monarchs. Night in Warsaw (2).

Day 3 Warsaw

Visit the Warsaw Rising Museum and the beautiful royal gardens of Łazienki Królewskie. Visit the Temple of Divine Providence and see the Pantheon of Great Poles. After lunch, visit St. Stanislaus Kostka Church and the grave of Blessed Jerzy Popieluszko, young Polish priest who was killed by communists for his support of the Solidarity Movement. Night in Warsaw (3).

Day 4 Warsaw, Częstochowa, Krakow

After breakfast, travel to Częstochowa to visit the Jasna Góra Monastery, one of the country's most important religious sites. After a visit to the shrine and lunch, travel to Krakow for an afternoon familiarization tour.

Night in Krakow (1).

Day 5

Krakow, Łagiewniki

Breakfast. Sunday Mass in Krakow. Sight-seeing tour with local guide to visit Wawel Hill, Wawel Cathedral, Sigimund's Chapel, Old Market, Mariacki Church. After lunch, visit Łagiewniki and the Sanctuary of Divine Mercy. Night in Krakow (2).

Day 6 Krakow, Wadowice

After breakfast, travel to Wieliczka for a guided tour of the UNESCO-listed Salt Mine. See magnificent chapels and captivating underground lakes. Travel to Wadowice, birth town of St. Pope John Paul II. After lunch, travel to Kalwaria Zebrzydowska, another UNESCO world heritage site, and see the beautiful chapels and parks frequented by St. John Paul II. Some say it was here that the pope developed his motto, "Totus tuus" (I belong to you, God and all that I possess is yours.) Free time to relax and explore. Return to Krakow for dinner. Night in Krakow (3).

Day 7 Zakopane

Breakfast. Travel to Zakopane. See the cemetery at Pęksowy Brzysek, the wooden church in Jaszczurówka, Krzeptówki Church. After lunch, free time on Krupówki, the most famous street for trade in Zakopane. Buy local products or relax in a local restaurant. Night in Zakopane (1).

Day 8 Bukowina Tatrzańska

Rest and relax at the thermal complex—thermal baths and geothermal pools. Return to Zakopane for lunch and travel to Gubalówka Hill by cable railway. Free time on Gubalówka. Night in Zakopane (2).

Day 9 Auschwitz

Breakfast. Travel to Auschwitz (Oświęcim). Guided tour of the Auschwitz-Birkenau Museum, Nazi concentration camp, and see St. Maximillian Kolbe's cell. Night in Zakopane (3).


Day 10 Krakow, North America
